PAGEANT EVER

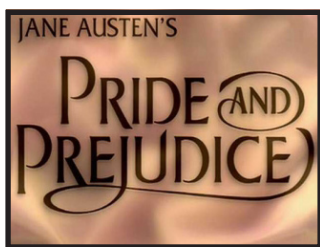

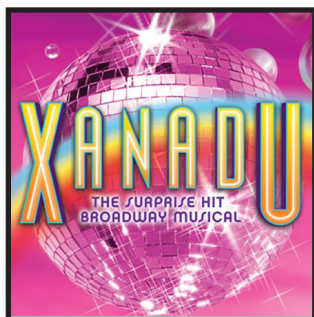
year's pageant the most unusual anyone has seen and, just possibly, the best one ever.

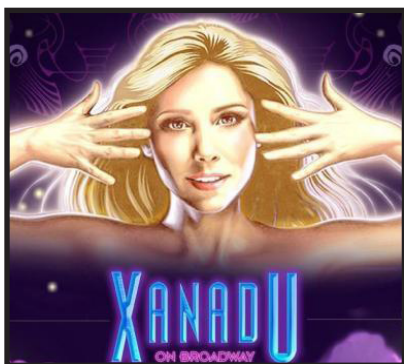
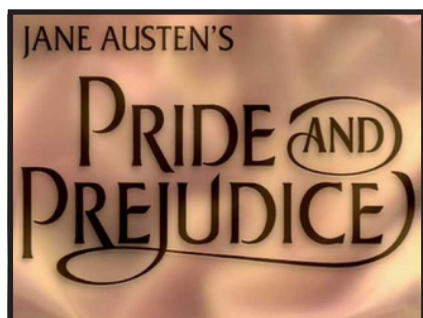
